## What is SCHOOL ADAPT project?

School adapt is a 36-month initiative under the Erasmus+ programme. It started on 1 September 2020 and will last until 31 August 2023. It is carried out by 5 partners from Poland, Italy, Cyprus and Spain.

The project aims to facilitate the adaptation process of pupils (6 to 14 years old) returning from abroad to the native education system and foreign pupils coming to a new country, to a new school life and environment. It is addressed to primary and lower-secondary schools across EU, pedagogical staff, school specialists and migrant parents.

The holistic approach of the project and a set of high-quality tools and resources will promote inclusive educational settings, empower teachers' workforce and accommodate the needs of all learners.

- 1.MODEL OF WORKING WITH A PUPIL RETURNING FROM ABROAD TO THE NATIVE EDUCATION SYSTEM Model supporting the schools and parents in transitioning a child to a new school (before departure & after arrival)
- 2.MODEL OF WORKING WITH A FOREIGN PUPIL COMING TO NEW COUNTRY (ADAPTATION OF FOREIGN PUPIL) Model supporting the schools and parents in transitioning a child to a new school (before departure & after arrival)
- 3.TRAINING TOOLKIT PUPIL ADAPTATION useful resource for pedagogical staff to implement the models into practice and create a productive and inclusive learning environment in a diverse classroom. It will contain simulation dialogues, training scenarios and materials.
- 4.CHANGING PERSPECTIVES: AN ONLINE E-LEARNING PLATFORM for teachers with a focus on facilitating school integration for foreign and returning students. There will be a series of short training to cover different topics of intercultural education, contemporary importance.
- 5.M-LEARNING COURSE FOR PARENTS online space to develop skills of parents for supporting their children in the process of changing schools and adapting to the new education system. Delivered in attractive, multimedia form.
